ABSTRACT. The purpose of this study is to examine generative artificial intelligence and ambient scene detection tools deploying mobile biometric and sentiment data, realistic movement simulations, and realtime predictive analytics in virtual work environments. "virtually simulated workspace environments." As research published in 2023 was inspected, only 173 articles satisfied the eligibility criteria, and 50 mainly empirical sources were selected. Data visualization tools: Dimensions (bibliometric mapping) and VOSviewer (layout algorithms). Reporting quality assessment tool: PRISMA. Methodological quality assessment tools include: AXIS, Dedoose, MMAT, and SRDR.
