

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Saint-Petersburg State University, represented by Sergey Andryushin, Vice Rector for International Affairs, from one side,

and

National Chengchi University, represented by Shu-Heng Chen, Vice President, from the other side,

acting on the basis of the Framework Agreement for Cooperation between the two respected universities, duly signed on 04.04.2012,

herewith agreed to prolong the Framework Agreement for Cooperation, duly signed on 04.04.2012, and the Exchange Protocol between Saint-Petersburg University, Russian Federation and National Chengchi University duly signed on 16.04.2012, for the next 5 (five) year period and hence to consider it as valid till 31.12.2022. Paragraph 2.1. of the Exchange Protocol shall be amended as follows: "The total number of exchange students from each Party shall not exceed 4 undergraduate or graduate students for one term or 2 for one academic year. In the exceptional cases the exchange period can be prolonged for more than it is stipulated in this Protocol." Paragraph 3.1. of the Exchange Protocol shall be amended as follows: "Each university may arrange for members of its faculty and/or research staff to visit the other university for research and/or teaching. The maximum number of visiting faculty and/or research staff from one university to the other will be 5 per academic year and the maximum total accumulated time of all visits within one academic year will be 75 days. Both universities should try to equalize the number per academic year of visiting faculty and research staff as well as the total accumulated time per academic year of all such visits between the two universities." Paragraph 3.2. of the Exchange Protocol shall be amended as follows: "A visit will normally last for a period from 14 days to 75 days".
