



## Agreement on Student Exchange between Technische Universität Darmstadt and Saint Petersburg University

Saint Petersburg University and TU Darmstadt may nominate 4 students per academic year (Bachelor, Master) for programs of study normally extending one semester or 2 students per academic year for programs of study extending one year. The receiving institution will consider these applications in accordance with its standard practice for admission of exchange students, although it will respect to the greatest extent possible the nominations of the sending institution.

- Students will maintain registration at the sending institution and will be charged no entrance examination fee or tuition by the receiving institution.

  For students coming to TU Darmstadt, the semester contribution without the administration fee (currently € 218,64, but subject to change) has to be paid. It includes the semester ticket for free use of public transportation, the contribution to the student union and the contribution to the students' organisation.
- Students in degree programs must satisfy language proficiency requirements of the host institution.
- Students will be requested to access the website for detailed information for exchange students.
- Exchange students will be expected to abide by the laws and customs of the host country and by the policies and regulations of the receiving institution.
- Exchange students who fail to maintain satisfactory academic performance and/or who violate the rules and regulations of the receiving institution may be subject to dismissal from the exchange. Every effort will be exercised to consult with appropriate officials of the sending institution prior to any sanction or disciplinary action.
- Each institution will establish dates for receipt of nominations of students for enrolment in academic year programs. Admissions decisions will be made in a timely manner and the sending institution notified of the decision. Students will be expected to arrive at the host campus by the date designated for new international students.
- Exchange students will be responsible for travel costs, living expenses, books, stationery, field trips, and incidental personal expenses.
- Exchange students may be housed in Residence Halls or appropriate University accommodations if applications are received for such accommodations in advance. Housing costs are the responsibility of the exchange student.
- Each student is required to have international medical insurance coverage including all medical, hospital and repatriation expenses while in the host country. At TU Darmstadt a German Health Insurance is required for enrollment.

During the academic year 2024/25 the exchange will be reviewed by each institution and a decision will be made to extend or terminate the agreement. In the event of major revision or cancellation of this agreement, the receiving institution will provide current participants with the opportunity to complete their approved program.
