



AGREEMENT

Saint-Petersburg State University

and

ICHEC Brussels Management School, Brussels, Belgium

The present agreement is signed between:

Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education “Saint-Petersburg State University” (hereinafter referred to as SPbU), duly represented by its Vice-Rector for International Affairs Sergey Andryushin, acting on the basis of proxy dated 21.12.2020 № 28-21-356,

And

The ICHEC Brussels Management School (hereinafter referred to as ICHEC), thereby represented by its Dean, Prof. Brigitte Chanoine.

In order to advance and enrich their academic programmes ICHEC and SPbU are herewith mutually entering into a formal agreement to promote exchange of teachers, researchers and students as well as the implementation of joint training, seminars, research and development activities.

Title I – Reciprocal student exchange

Article 1

1. Qualifying students are those holding high academic standards who are in the third year of ICHEC Bachelor degrees or second year of ICHEC Masters and those students from SPbU in their final two years of their degree.
2. A maximum of 3 students will be sent to the partner institution each academic year.

Article 2

1. Both institutions agree to accept courses set out in their reciprocal programmes as a basis for credits transfer and academic recognition.
2. Students will be required to pass regular exams to obtain such credits and a grade transcript.
3. Visiting students will not be seeking a degree at the host institution and will attend regular classes.

Article 3

Both institutions are committed to offering relevant business courses for visiting students.

Article 4

1. Both institutions agree to assist incoming students from the partner institution namely with accommodation.
2. No payment will be made by the host institution to the visiting students.

Article 5

Students will pay tuition fees to their home institution. Students from both institutions are responsible for their own travel costs, paying for room and board, books, local and international travel and personal expenses.

Article 6

Host institution laws regulations and institutional procedures apply to all incoming students under this agreement.

Title II – Faculty Exchange

Article 8

Both institutions agree to promote exchange among their respective faculties under the form of short-term guest lecturing, visiting professorships for the duration of a semester and joint research.

Title III – Executive Programmes

Article 9

Both institutions agree to aim at the expansion of their international perspective by encouraging development of cross-cultural executive education programs.

Title IV – Liaising

Article 10

Each partner institution shall appoint a member of staff to be responsible for the implementation of the Agreement and act as liaison between institutions.

Title V – Extend and duration

Article 11

1. The present agreement is in effect as of academic year 2021/22, and may be subject to change by mutual consent.
2. Any alteration of amendment to this agreement must be made in writing and agreed by both Parties.

Article 12

The Parties hereto may terminate the present agreement by delivering at least six months written notice of termination to the other party.

Should any dispute or disagreement arise between the Parties connected with or concerning the Agreement, the Parties shall first try to resolve the dispute by negotiations. If the dispute has not been resolved by such negotiations within 30 days since the dispute arose, the Parties shall be free to submit the dispute to a court of the respondent's place of business. The applicable law is law of the country where the questionable commitment arose.

Both Parties shall not use names and logos of the other Party without its prior consent, if it is not directly related to the performance of obligations under this Agreement except as provided by law.

The Parties agree to post on their websites reciprocally information about the partner university, including reference link to the universities' websites and links to online courses/MOOCs.




